Dataset Description:

This dataset consists of a table containing information regarding all the degree programmes offered at the University of Jaén (UJA) in the academic year 2023/2024. Each row includes basic information about the programme, such as the name, International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED) fields and codes, and number of registered students, among other data.

Reasons for this dataset:

The dataset is intended to convey information on the university's current academic offer in terms of the degree programmes and the students registered in the academic year 2023/2024.

Validity and traceability of information, sources, websites:

The information was obtained from the Statistical Yearbook of the University of Jaén, and from the official documents of each degree programme, which are publicly available on the university's website (www.ujaen.es).

Dataset limitations

There is no information for the National Classification field. In this column, we have included the ISCED Fields of Education and Training recorded in the official documents of the given degree programme (usually two ISCED Fields). The corresponding ISCED codes have been divided in two columns, namely ISCED1 and ISCED2.

In the case of coexisting old and new versions for the same degree programme, added values of the two versions have been provided as the total the number of students. This is the case of the Bachelor's degree in Geography and History, Bachelor's degree in Art History, Master's degree in Marketing and Consumer Behaviour, Master's degree in Law and Procurement, and Master's degree in Research and Teaching in Physical Activity and Health Science.

Data regarding ages of the students was not available for Master's and PhD's programmes.

There are 128 rows in the dataset, with the first one containing column headings.
