- **Course of study/ Subject area** – Name of the study program or subject area (in the original language).
- **Course of study ENG** – English translation of the study program or subject area.
- **Course of study type** – Type of study program (e.g., Bachelor's, Master's, PhD) in the original language.
- **Course of study type ENG** – English translation of the study program type.
- **Home University** – Name of the student's home university.
- **Home university geographical coordinates** – Geographic coordinates of the home university.
- **Home university country** – Country of the home university.
- **NEOLAiA University** – Indicates whether the home university is a NEOLAiA Alliance member.
- **Number of male students** – Number of male students involved in the mobility flow.
- **Number of female students** – Number of female students involved in the mobility flow.

- **Number of total students** – Total number of students involved in the mobility flow.
- **Host Facility** – Host department/faculty at UNISA (in the original language).
- **Host Facility ENG** – English translation of the host department/faculty.
- **Host University** – Name of the host university (UNISA).

- **Host university geographical coordinates** – Geographic coordinates of the host university.
- **Host university Country** – Country of the host university (Italy).
- **ISCED** – International Standard Classification of Education code for the subject area.
- **Number of students with National citizenship** – Number of students with Italian citizenship.
- **Number of students with EU citizenship** – Number of students with EU citizenship.
- **Number of students with Non-EU citizenship** – Number of students with non-EU citizenship.
- **Activity: Exams** – Students involved in exam activities.
- **Activity: Thesis** – Students involved in thesis-related activities.
- **Activity: internship** – Students doing an internship.
- **Activity: Exams/thesis** – Students involved in both exams and thesis work.
- **Activity: Exams/internship** – Students engaged in exams and internship.
- **Activity: Thesis/internship** – Students engaged in thesis work and internship.

As for the information about the host university, in this case all data refer to UNISA. However, these fields are useful when merging datasets from all NEOLAiA universities.
