Dataset Description:

EU-funded projects involving the nine partner universities of the NEOLAIa alliance under the 2021–2027 Multiannual Financial Framework, updated to April 2026.

This dataset provides a comprehensive overview of EU-funded projects in which NEOLAIa partner universities participated between 2021 and 2025. Each row represents a distinct funded project and includes information such as the project ID, acronym, title, duration, programme, role of the university, funding details, and relevant URLs.

The projects span multiple EU programmes, including Horizon Europe and Erasmus+, and reflect the collective research and innovation activity across the alliance.

Reasons for this dataset:

This dataset was created with the aim of mapping the participation of NEOLAIa partner universities in EU-funded research and innovation projects within the 2021–2027 programming period. By integrating data from all nine universities, it provides a broader and more representative overview of the alliance’s involvement in European initiatives.

The dataset supports both internal strategic planning and external communication, highlighting the collective impact and collaboration potential of NEOLAIa institutions.

Moreover, it contributes to the implementation of the NEOLAIa Open Science Policy by promoting transparency, encouraging the sharing of best practices, and fostering a culture of openness. It also enables comparative analysis across partner universities, supporting informed decision-making and strengthening collaboration within the alliance.

Validity and traceability of information, sources, websites:

All information included in this dataset has been derived from the individual datasets of each NEOLAIa partner university. Detailed sources and data collection methodologies can be found in the corresponding methodological notes of each original dataset, available at:

Additionally, data have been cross-checked and validated against the CORDIS database to correct potential errors and inconsistencies present in the original datasets.

Dataset limitations:

- Some financial details (e.g., total project budget) may be incomplete or not publicly available

- Differences in data availability and reporting standards across universities may affect consistency; in some cases, inconsistencies have been corrected

In order to ensure harmonization and comparability across institutions, adjustments have been applied to the data. These include standardization of numerical formats, alignment of units and figures, and normalization of project status categories.

Minor discrepancies with the original datasets may still occur, particularly regarding project status. This is due to the fact that the integrated dataset has been updated using a more recent reference date and validated against external sources.

The project status field (e.g., “Ongoing”, “Closed”) has been updated considering the new publication date of the dataset.
